

We want to remind you that all students in Fulton County Schools now have access to Naviance, which can be accessed through [ClassLink](#). Starting this year, our school will be using Naviance to process and submit transcripts, letters of recommendation, and other college application documents.

This year as you begin your senior year, we strongly encourage you, to visit Naviance to research colleges, careers and scholarships! After doing your research and once you compile a list of colleges you are applying to you will find that different colleges will require you to apply using different platforms. Important Changes to Common Application and Requesting Letters of Recommendation:

For Common Application, once you create your account, we ask that you **NOT** invite any teachers or counselors to write letters of recommendation through Common App until after you **match your Common App account with your Naviance account**. Requesting letters of recommendation in Common App before matching your Naviance account will create errors. **Therefore, please hold off on requesting recommendations until after you match your accounts**.
